## What Do I Do Next?

There are 4 stages to the recruitment process for these roles:

1. Submit an application form
2. Short-listing process
3. Invitation to an interview
4. References and Criminal Records Checks will be needed

*Counselling and Helpline Support Workers will need to commit to an in-house training programme (over a 20-week period) to equip you with the necessary knowledge and skills to support victims. This course is heavily subsidised so we ask for a voluntary donation as a means of contributing towards the cost of running the programme.*

In-house **clinical supervision** will be provided free of charge.

RoSA operates within a framework for strict ethical guidelines as set by the BACP.
